

Apply now for a Bursary opportunity from
The Government Technical Advisory Centre (GTAC) to complete your
Master's degree.

The Government Technical Advisory Centre (GTAC), an agency of the National Treasury, is offering up to ten bursaries to students eligible to complete their Master's degree in Economics in 2019. On the successful completion of their studies, bursary holders may be offered an internship opportunity at the National Treasury and/or GTAC.

This programme gives you the opportunity to be part of an exciting cadre of young economists in the public sector, working alongside experienced economists, to enhance your experiential and applied skills in a wide range of public economics and policy analysis areas.

A condition of the bursary is that you include public economics or public policy modules in your course selection. You will also be strongly encouraged to select an aspect of a public economics policy challenge as the topic for your (mini) thesis, to be agreed in consultation with GTAC and your supervisor.

Applications close on 17 September 2018. Interviews are expected to happen towards the end of September and successful applicants will be advised by the end of October 2018.

Minimum selection criteria include the following. You must:

- Be a South African citizen
- Hold a completed Honours degree in Economics (by March 2019)
- Have achieved an average minimum pass rate of 65%
- Be fluent in English and
- Be interested in pursuing a career in the public sector

Applications must include:

- Your curriculum vitae,
- Your full academic record and proof of academic qualifications (i.e. certified copies of high school and university degrees and certificates)
- Two academic references and

A letter of motivation to support your application, demonstrating your interest in a public sector career.
